In 2015, to commemorate the 500 year anniversary of the Reinheitsgebot, Toni Scwendl revived his grandparent's original wheat beer recipe from 1935. It is a very unique wheat beer. He uses both pale and dark malts that give the beer an amber color. It is also stronger

than a traditional Helle Weisse measuring in at 5.8%abv. It is full bodied and unfiltered, with a mild bitterness along with fruity notes. It has become so popular in his region he is now brewing it all year round. However, here in America, it is only available from the end of September through November.
